President's Report:

Sarasota recycling container replacements.

The county will begin replacements of all current recycling containers in November with a new large container with wheels and an attached lid. Both paper/cardboard and cans/glass will all go into the one container.

This new service is to start county wide on January 6, 2020.

These new containers will NOT fit into our garbage closet. We will still have our garbage containers for garbage disposal.

Also, the club house and maintenance building will not be eligible for new containers. The county will consider them as commercial and we would have to either put those items in some one's villa container or we would have to have a large dumpster in our parking lot. I think that would be a material alteration and require a 2/3 positive vote of all owners.

The county has offered five solutions to us. None of which, in my opinion, are acceptable.

Their solutions are:

- 1. Utilizing the keyhole for storage.
- 2. For villas that do not have a keyhole, store the containers on the side of the villa.
- 3. Have residents place the container within their utility room.
- 4. Revise the Association rules to allow containers to be stored within the carport.
- 5. Use common area for a dumpster and residents will have to take their recyclables to the dumpster.

At this time, I left a message/request with Channel 7 to have them come out here to do an interview.

Also, I left a request to talk to our county commissioner for help. I have not heard back from either at this point.

I did receive a call from Larry Alexander, Sarasota County Solid Waste Manager, requesting to meet with me. We met this past Monday along with Don Puls and Steve Zimmerman. We explained our problems with the solutions that had been given to SRV. I also informed him that 145 of the 336 villas are owned by single women in this over 55 condominium complex.

I stressed that they would have a difficult time with these new containers and especially if they have to bring them to a central collection point. Some of these seniors do not have a car. Mr. Alexander said he would get back to us and try to come up with a solution.

The Safety and Security Committee Members are: Larry Gill – Chairman, Vince Doherty, Jim Goese, Jack Needles, Bob Piper and Bob Dressler. Our meeting time is the third Wednesday of each month at 9am at the clubhouse.

Residents Returning – SRV will begin to get a little busier as we move into our Fall and Winter seasons. Please follow our speed limits when driving in SRV. Drivers should yield to pedestrians and cyclists and walkers should remember to walk facing traffic.

Solicitors – Several solicitors were asked to leave SRV over the summer months. We expect more to come around as our seasonal residents return. Remember that SRV has a "No Soliciting – No Trespassing" policy. If you have someone come to your door soliciting any product or service, please ask them to leave SRV and/or call the Office or Safety & Security to ask them to leave.

Storm Season – Florida's Hurricane season runs through November 30th. The peak of the season is September, but Florida has had many late season storms in October or November. Please remain prepared and review the SRV Hurricane Preparedness Plan for more helpful information. Copies are available in the office.

Vehicle Identification Stickers (VIS) and Guest Parking Permits – Per our Rules & Regulations Vehicle Identification Stickers are mandatory for your personal vehicles parked in SRV. These stickers are to be affixed to the rear window on the driver's side. Stickers may be picked up at the office during regular business hours and are free. Guest Parking Permits are also available at the office. These permits hang from the rearview mirror and should be used when you have overnight guests who park their vehicles in SRV or for the restricted vehicles required to park in the clubhouse south parking lot. These Guest Parking Permits are reusable and can be kept at your villa to use when needed. Both the VIS and the Guest Parking Permits help Safety & Security identify vehicles that belong on our property.

Grounds Report



September, 2019

Members of the S.R.V. Grounds/Landscape team bid all a warm welcome as we begin a new season. Your team has been active all summer with many activities and impromptu meetings; of particular mention:

- * Effective January 1, 2020 a new landscape contract will commence. A total of eight (8) Landscape companies were interviewed and vetted. A Request for Proposal (RFP) was mailed to seven (7) companies; six (6) responses were received. All of the data from the submitted bids has been analyzed and published in a 15 page document. This document has been provided to the Board of Directors. The first meeting of the Board of Directors is September 26, 2019, at which time the Board is expected to select the winning bid.
- * Annual trimming and removal of several trees has been completed. Many trees were at the end of their life; some trees were dead, or diseased. Three (3) additional trees will be removed in September. The annual pruning of all 500 plus palm tree will be completed in October. Our 2019 tree budget is \$40,000 and we will utilize all of these monies.
- * The re-planting of trees and shrubs on Riverbluff Circle, at the rear fence line has been completed. A total of fourteen (14) trees/shrubs were planted. Plantings included were: (4) Weeping Bottlebrush Trees, (3) Christmas Palm Trees (2) Areca Palm Trees, (2) Jasmine Bushes and (2) Copper Leaf Shrubs. The plantings look amazing and were completed at a cost of \$1,966.00. Thanks to the committee for all your work and effort in design, selection, and watering. Thank you to the nearby residents for your patience for this long awaited project.

Building Committee Report

September 19, 2019

A Building Committee Meeting was held September 10, 2019 with the following in attendance: Doug Spencer, Steve Salemi, Bill Hallisey and myself. Also attending were Shawn Gubody. Items discussed are listed below.

Pickelball – Booce Ball Courts: New estimates and some previous estimates were reviewed, they were all very expensive and no location in SRV was defined in the estimates. The committee discussed the use of the many existing Pickelball Courts that are available in the County and City Parks. Research is continuing. It is suggested that an interest survey for these activities be prepared and administerd by SRV Programs and Services.

Shuffleboard Court Covers: We reviewed some estimates which were very costly. We are looking for lower cost covers or assessing the need for any cover at all, since the use of the courts during the year is low except for the Jan., Feb. competion.

Road Sealing: Sealing will be done by Asphalt Repair Service beginning in October. THERE WILL BE SOME INCONVIENCE, PLEASE COPERATE. Shawn will be setting up cones to direct traffic.

Villa Painting: Villa painting in section one will be continuing as we complete the scheduled villas for this year. The BOD will be voting on a 5 year contract at the Sept. BOD meeting. If approved. SRV will be on the painting contactors yearly schedule for the following years. This gives SRV a more convenient time of the year for SRV.

Boat Dock Warranty Repair: Materials and Documents were gathered and assembled. Justin Gonzalez LCAM, Argus Property Management, took that information and prepared a letter which was sent to Att. Jennifer Horan, Becker & Poliakoff, for evaluation and recommendation as to how to proceed. Att. Jennifer referred SRV to Att. Sanjay Kurian a Board Certified Construction Law Att. This resulted in a phone meeting with Att. Sanjay Kurian and Att. Jennifer Horan 9/06/19. This phone meeting was attended by Justin Gonzalez, Jerry McDermottt, Steve Zimmermin, Don Puls and Shawn Gubody . On the phone, Att. Kurian after discussion and questions: The amount SRV had paid for the job, Number of change orders, The root of the complaint, Did SRV have another Engineers opinion of the recommended fix for the Original Problem (Root Cause), Was there a Manufactures Warrant on the produce used? Att. Kurian recommended SRV have an out of the area Engineer give SRV an opinion of how the job should have been done correctly before SRV proceeds. No Engineer has been recommended at this time.

Swimming Pool Pumps: Repairs to these pumps and valves has become critical in order to maintain the pool. Repairs are being done as an emergency. A complete replacement of the Pump House and the enclosed equipment is being investigated.

Villa Alterations and Repair: In order for the SRV Board of Directors to approve any alterations or repairs to your villa, a "Request to Modify Condominium Property" form must be completed and submitted to the office with a copy of the Sarasota County Building Permit, and copies of the Contractor License and proof of Liability Insurance.

These Documents are REQUIRED by Sarasota County and the SRV Rules and Regulations before the work can be APPROVED by the SRV Board and BEFORE the WORK can begin. If the work is started without approval the WORK will be stopped and Sarasota County will be notified which could cause a FINE by the county and/or reversal of the work. The "Request to Modify Condominium Property" form and Sarasota County Permit information sheet are available from the SRV office

Welcome back to all the snowbirds. I would like to take the time to thank many people for their help this summer. First, I would like to thank Bloomings Landscape for all their time in regards to the water leak investigation in section one. Quinten and his team along with Bob and Rob clearly went above and beyond to help solve and locate a major leak in this section. Even though this leak had nothing to do with the irrigation system, the Bloomings team was still willing to help. I would also like to thank Sean Lucille, from Sarasota County Utilities for his help with coordinating water shut-offs and finding the leak in section one. Also a big shout out to Danny T. Young and his team from Sarasota County Utilities for the

night of August 22, 2019. Danny's crew and myself worked tirelessly overnight to repair a sewer main that had broke in section one. Thank you from everyone at SRV.

Villa painting will begin soon in Section One, weather permitting. The villas that will be painted in this round, have been notified via the one call system. More information will be sent out to those affected. If you have received your notice, please start planning for the removal of the items on your walls, in your keyhole and around your villa.

Sealing of the roadways will start within the next few weeks. As soon as the schedule is completed, a map and schedule will be provided showing the dates of when your area roads will be done. Please be patient with the sealing process as this is a necessity to extend the life of our roadways.

If you are doing trimming/weeding at your villa, you can use recyclable or paper bags to place your yard waste in. Yard waste should not be set at the curb until Monday. As a reminder, garbage or plastic bags can't be used as they are not acceptable at the landfill.

Please do not park on the roadway. Be responsible for your guests, contractors etc. and be aware of where they are parking. The roadways are too narrow for the garbage trucks etc. trying to get by when vehicles are parked on the road. Parking on the grass is causing our sprinkler heads to be broken.

Gutters need to be inspected and cleaned at least once a year. Cleaning of gutters is an owner responsibility.

If you have major plumbing repairs at your villa, please consider providing a copy of your paid invoice to the office to be turned in to the county for credits on our water/sewer bills.

Maintenance work orders are to be filled out and turned in to the office, if you are requesting work to be done. As a reminder, these are only requests and may not be an association approved request. For example, the association will not clean your roof or clean your gutters.

Thank you to Frank and Dianne Wilson for making multiple trips to the County Landfill to dispose of chemicals/paint from the shop to be disposed of properly. Please remember that the shop and dumpster area are not collection sites for your unwanted chemicals/paints.

As a resident of SRV, everyone wants to keep the property beautiful. Everyone can do their part. "Don't Pass it up, pick it up." Return patio chairs etc. to the place you found them in.


