

President's Report:

Results of the October meeting of the Board of Directors.

Linda Meyer was appointed Chair of the Election Committee.

Don and Margaret Quitter have held this position in the past but have other commitments this December and needed to resign from the Chairmanship. The Board accepted their resignation and thanks them for their past service to SRV.

The Board approved the SRV 2019 budget. The monthly fee per villa starting January 1, 2019 will be \$351.00. This includes both the Operating and Reserve Budgets.

The Board approved minor changes to the Rules & Regulations. All owners will receive the new pages to be inserted into your documents. The new Rules and Regulations go into effect Nov. 25, 2018.

Board approved the purchase of one additional security camera for the office area. Also four Motorola two way radios for better and faster communications, when needed, between the office, maintenance personnel and Safety and Security Committee.

Board approved having Sarasota Document provide a locked 95 gal. tote container for SRV residents to insert documents that they wish to have shredded. The plan is to have this available for a two week period once in the fall and once in the spring. There is NO cost to those taking advantage of this service. The cost to the association is \$50.00 for each two week period.

Reminder to all that the next Board Meeting will be November 15th not November 22nd because of Thanksgiving.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Month Ending September 30, 2018 And Year-to-date (YTD) January 1, 2018 through September 30, 2018

Balance Sheet

SRV's Balance Sheet for September reflects Total Assets of \$1,091,198.93 vs. Liabilities of \$640,204.92 resulting in an Equity position of \$450,994.01

Total Revenue for September of \$117,146.51 was slightly below budget by \$64.24

Total Expenses for September of \$125,981.48 was over budget by \$8,770.74

The main contributors to the overage were:

- > 7440 · Rec Facility over budget by \$5,570.78 (bathroom updates)
- ➤ 7810 Insurance expense over budget by \$15,637.93

Most all other categories were under budget by approx. \$12,000 thereby offsetting the items listed above.

Net Income for September was a negative \$8,834.97

Revenue Year-to-date (YTD) of \$1,066,055.58 has exceeded budget by \$5,908.83

Expenses Year-to-date (YTD) of \$1,070,748.15 are ahead of budget by \$10,601.40

Net Income Year-to-date (YTD) is a negative \$4,692.57

Your many calls and heart felt complements on how beautiful the grounds are being transformed are truly appreciated. Thank You.

At the January 2019 Board meeting a Request For Proposal (RFP) document will be presented to the Board for review, discussion, and approval. This document will be offered to selected contractors to bid on our total landscape requirements, beginning on October 22, 2019. This is the date our existing contract with Bloomings Landscape Company ends. The Grounds Committee will offer the Request For Proposal (RFP) to 4-5 vetted vendors. Note that Bloomings Landscape Company will indeed be offered this opportunity in light of their long-term relationship with S.R.V. Your Grounds Committee views this task as one of the most important endeavors we have undertaken.

Two (2) hours, every Monday, weather permitting. Meet at the clubhouse parking lot, at 7:00 a.m. sharp. Bring gloves, pruning shears, rakes, etc. A cooler of ice-cold bottled water is always available.

Safety and Security Report



October, 2018

The Safety and Security Committee Members are: Larry Gill – Chairman, Vince Doherty, Jim Goese, Jack Needles, Bob Piper and Bob Dressler. Our meeting time is the third Wednesday of each month at 9:00am at the clubhouse. Please bring any comment or questions to discuss to our next meeting or write them down and put them in the "Suggestion and Idea Box" or contact a committee member. Your ideas, comments, and suggestions are always welcome.

Solicitors, non-residents on property – The end of September Safety and Security asked four people to leave our property. One was a political worker going door-to-door promoting their candidate, one was a homeless woman who was using our contractor's bathroom at the clubhouse and two teenage boys dropped off by their mother to fish in the marina. All left peacefully, although the homeless woman had a few colorful words while departing. Please report any solicitors to the office or Safety & Security.

Threatening Behavior by Owner – During the first weeks of October, on two occasions, a SRV owner exhibited threatening behavior towards our Maintenance Supervisor Shawn and our Office Manager Nan and a verbal threat against our Property Manager Justin. On the first occasion this person told Shawn he had a pocket of rocks he would throw at him, and on a second occasion displayed a Taser, which he activated in an aggressive movement, threatening Nan, saying this was for Justin. This person on Monday the 15th parked his vehicle with a camera aimed at and watching the front door of our clubhouse in what is believed to be for watching when Shawn or Nan came or went or when one or the other was alone in the clubhouse. The Sarasota County Sheriff's office was called twice, but has been unable to make contact with this individual as of this report. The case is still open. The theory is this person was upset with the association due to his roof mansard had a leak that he believed the association should be responsible to repair. He was told that the roof maintenance is the owner's responsibility and that all repairs had to be consistent with SRV's rules for paint color and material, apparently upsetting him. This threatening, aggressive behavior has made it necessary for SRV to add an additional security camera to our security system, purchase two-way radios for our office and maintenance staff to always be in contact with each other and added security personnel at the clubhouse when Nan is alone.

Speed limits and responsible driving – As more of our seasonal residents return to SRV, our streets are fuller with cars, bike riders and people walking the community. Please slow down, look both ways for cars, bike riders or people out for a walk, especially when backing out of your carport. Safety & Security received a report recently of a couple almost being hit by a car backing out from the carport. Please remember to ride your bike on the right side of the road riding with traffic and walk on the left side of the road facing traffic. Obeying the speed limit and stop signs are recurring problems in SRV, please be a responsible driver and slow down. Also remember to park your vehicle or your guest's vehicle in the carport or a designated parking space. Do not park on the side of the roadway.




